<b>Event name</b>	2014-2016 CEV Beach Volleyball Continental Cup – 1 <sup>st</sup> & 2 <sup>nd</sup> Round
<b>Application form</b>	Duly completed BV-A form
<b>Application deadline</b>	<b>14<sup>th</sup> February 2014</b> for 1 <sup>st</sup> Round events to be announced in a later stage for 2 <sup>nd</sup> Round events
<b>Competition Dates</b>	1 <sup>st</sup> Round in May/June - 2 <sup>nd</sup> Round in August/September Exact dates be coordinated and approved by CEV
EVENT CONDITIONS	
<b>Stadium capacity</b>	Min. 500 seats (including reserved seating for VIPs, players, officials, etc.)
<b>Number of courts</b>	Minimum 2 competition courts + 2 warm-up courts
<b>Duration of competition</b>	Minimum 2 days
<b>Competition format - Number of teams</b>	Double gender events with min. 4 and max. 5 National Federations per gender. The events will be played in a country vs. country format and each country participates with 2 teams per gender. Each National Federation's delegation consists of 4 athletes plus a min. of 1 and a max. of 2 delegation members (NF Delegate, coach, doctor or physiotherapist) per gender. <u>1<sup>st</sup> Round Ranking</u> : top two National Federations qualify to the 3 <sup>rd</sup> Round, all other teams qualify to the 2 <sup>nd</sup> Round <u>2<sup>nd</sup> Round Ranking</u> : top two National Federations qualify to the 3 <sup>rd</sup> Round, other teams are eliminated Results of the 1 <sup>st</sup> and 2 <sup>nd</sup> Round will be taken into consideration for the seeding in the 3 <sup>rd</sup> Round
<b>Prize Money</b>	No Prize Money
<b>Venue/court layout</b>	To be approved by the CEV
<b>Venue Facilities</b>	In accordance with the current CEV Regulations
<b>Court Equipment</b>	CEV/FIVB approved
<b>Stadium Insurance</b>	Mandatory
<b>CEV Sanction fee</b>	No
ORGANISERS OBLIGATIONS	
<b>National Federation</b>	To assign the Referee Manager and local referees, line judges and scorers according to the numbers quoted in the CEV Regulations (English language skills are mandatory)
<b>Number of referees</b>	Both neutral and national depending on number of teams, courts and duration (minimum of 1 Neutral referee per competition court)
<b>Medical staff</b>	Medical doctor and physiotherapist available during all competition days
<b>Travel costs</b> (round trip economy class airplane tickets)	1 CEV Technical Supervisor and 1 CEV Referee Delegate. In case of a second venue this number will increase due to the need of appointing assistants for both CEV officials. Neutral referees assigned by CEV
<b>Board and Lodging</b> (★★★-Hotel or better)	CEV appointed Officials and Referees according to CEV Regulations. All Delegations from the day of the Technical Meeting until the day after the event conclusion in twin rooms.

<b>Per diem (85,- EUR)</b>	To all CEV assigned Officials and referees, including arrival and departure days
<b>Local transportation</b>	For all CEV Officials, referees and participating delegations
<b>Inspection visit</b>	To be decided case by case
<b>Clothing</b>	For CEV officials and referees only. Each participating National Federation has to provide their players with two different colors of uniforms (Men: tank tops and shorts; Women: tops and bikini bottoms), layout and sponsoring as per CEV Marketing regulations
<b>Awards</b>	Trophies (1 per delegation per gender) to Federations classified 1 <sup>st</sup> , 2 <sup>nd</sup> and 3 <sup>rd</sup> .
<b>Television production</b>	Optional. In case of TV production this must follow the CEV guidelines and the TV signal should be made available and free of charge to CEV on a European Satellite (if requested).
<b>Post Event Report</b>	Including a highlight video clip, press clippings and media report, photo DVD/CD, sample of all printed materials.
<b>ORGANISERS BENEFITS</b>	
<b>Contribution to Organiser</b>	<b>16.000.- EUR</b> in case organizing a pool of 4 National Federation <b>19.000.- EUR</b> in case organizing a pool of 5 National Federation 30 MIKASA VLS balls and 3 sets of JINLING sets of nets and court lines
<b>TV rights</b>	National TV rights in case of nominating a host broadcaster. International TV and internet rights remain with the CEV.
<b>Calendar exclusivity</b>	No other CEV homologated event in the hosting country territory
<b>FIVB/CEV Ranking Points</b>	Yes
<b>CEV Website</b>	Yes
<b>Competition Software</b>	Yes
<b>MARKETING - PROMOTION</b>	
<b>Product categories</b>	CEV reserves the following product categories until a certain date: Airlines, balls, cars, fashion wear, sportswear, body care products All other categories remain with the organizer
<b>Advertising, commercial rights for organisers</b>	Use of the Marks of the CEV and the event; Appointment of national sponsors/partners; All private and governmental subsidies; Merchandising
<b>Panels, Flags and Backdrops</b>	70% of panels and flags surrounding the center and side courts plus 70% of total area in official backdrops to the organizers. Materials to be produced by the organizer, according to CEV Marketing Regulations
<b>Time out areas</b>	100% with the organizer
<b>Referee Chair, Net bands, posts</b>	50% with the organiser, 50% with CEV
<b>Staff Uniforms</b>	100% with the organizers, excluding the CEV pre-determined position
<b>Printed Material, access passes, etc.</b>	Incorporating sponsors of both the organiser and CEV in accordance to the approved event visual
<b>Promotional Plan</b>	To submit and work in collaboration with CEV a plan including but not limited on-site activities & media actions before and during the event
